DON'T FORGET

ESSENTIALS

- FLASHLIGHT / BATTERIES

- RADIO (SATTERY OPERATED AND NOAA WEATHER RADIO) - CASH (BANKS MAY NOT BE OPEN OR AVAILABLE FOR EXTENDED PERIODS)

- FIRST AID KIT / MEDICINES / PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

- KEYS

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS IN A WATERPROOF CONTAINER INSURANCE, MEDICAL RECORDS, BANK ACCOUNT NUMBERS, SOCIAL SECURITY CARD, ETC.] - TOOLS (KEEP A SET WITH YOU DURING THE STORM)

- VEHICLE FUEL TANKS FILLED
- -BLANKETS / PILLOWS, ETC
- -CLOTHING (SEASONAL, RAIN GEAR, STURDY SHOES)
- SPECIAL ITEMS FOR BABIES AND THE ELDERLY
- TOILETRIES / HYGIENE ITEMS

-MOISTURE WIPES
