WATER & FOOD

- AT LEAST 1 GALLON OF WATER PER PERSON FOR 3 TO 7 DAYS & AT LEAST ENOUGH FOOD FOR 3 TO 7 DAYS (NON-PERISHABLE PACKAGED OR CANNED FOOD.)

DON'T FORGET:

NON-PERISHABLE PACKAGED OR CANNED FOOD, JUICE, FOOD FOR INFANTS AND THE ELDERLY, SNACK FOOD, PET FOOD, NON-ELECTRIC CAN OPENER, COOKING TOOLS, COOKING FUEL, PAPER PLATES & PLASTIC UTENSILS

ESSENTIALS

- FLASHLIGHT / BATTERIES
- RADIO (BATTERY OPERATED AND NOAA WEATHER RADIO)
- CASH (BANKS MAY NOT BE OPEN OR AVAILABLE FOR EXTENDED PERIODS.)
- FIRST AID KIT / MEDICINES / PRESCRIPTION DRUGS
- KEYS
- IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS IN A WATERPROOF CONTAINER (INSURANCE, MEDICAL RECORDS, BANK ACCOUNT NUMBERS, SOCIAL SECURITY CARD, ETC.)
- TOOLS (KEEP A SET WITH YOU DURING THE STORM)
- VEHICLE FUEL TANKS FILLED
- BLANKETS / PILLOWS, ETC
- CLOTHING (SEASONAL, RAIN GEAR, STURDY SHOES)
- SPECIAL ITEMS FOR BABIES AND THE ELDERLY
- TOILETRIES / HYGIENE ITEMS
- MOISTURE WIPES

PET CARE ITEMS

- PROPER IDENTIFICATION / IMMUNIZATION RECORDS
- AMPLE SUPPLY OF FOOD & WATER
- A CARRIER / CAGE
- MEDICATIONS
- MUZZLE / LEASH
- PET WASTE SUPPLIES
